

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Congratulations! Your student has been registered for online Language Arts coursework through Achieve 3000. Every student was guided through the login process during his or her English class. At the time, they also received instructions on how to navigate the platform. The first in-class assignment was to complete a pre-test for prerequisite skills necessary for success in English class.

Purpose and Goal?

The purpose of Achieve 3000 is to enhance students' reading Lexile scores, and the specific goal is to facilitate improvement in overall academic achievement and performance on standardized assessments.

How does my student get started outside?

Once your student logs in, they will arrive at the **Dashboard**, where students have been trained to navigate through the program.

Your student's teacher guided the class through how to answer questions and began coursework a few weeks ago. For technical support or other questions, **call 877-235-2525**. The online Help page includes useful videos and FAQs to help troubleshoot at home.

A special note, Stilwell students can access the platform at home Monday – Friday, 6am – 10pm.

How will my student complete coursework?

If your student does not meet the passing score on the first attempt (ranging from 70% - 80%), the system will automatically reassign the assignment up to three times, or until the student meets the passing score. The teacher is able to track each student's progress and offer guidance throughout the assignments. While students may receive guidance during practice in the lessons, we encourage students to work independently on the quizzes and tests so the teacher may receive an accurate account of your child's knowledge for the concept.

Tips for Success

- Students should log in regularly (between 60-90 minutes per week) and stay on pace.
- Frequently view the academic snapshot to identify areas of improvement.
- Stay on task. Students will be timed out of an assignment if they do not click on anything "clickable" (such as a button, or question response) within 25 minutes.
- If you need help, ask for it! Bring questions and attempted work to class or extra help sessions after school.
