

Dual Enrollment at Stilwell School of the Arts

Move On When Ready is Georgia's new **dual enrollment program** that allows high school students (9th – 12th grade) to earn college credit while working on their high school diploma.

Steps to participate in Dual Enrollment/MOWR at Stilwell:

1. Contact the admissions office of the Dual Enrollment/MOWR college to which you are applying and inquire about their admission requirements
2. Take the SAT/ACT; the score needs to meet the requirements of your Dual Enrollment/MOWR college to which you are applying
3. Complete the college Dual Enrollment/MOWR application by the deadline
4. Complete the Dual Enrollment/MOWR participation agreement application online by going to www.GAfutures.org (each semester of Dual Enrollment/MOWR) and provide a signed copy of the application to your high school counselor.
5. When you receive your Dual Enrollment/MOWR acceptance letter from your college, schedule an appointment to meet with your grade level counselor and your college advisor to select your courses
6. You must provide your own transportation to and from your Dual Enrollment college

*******The requirements listed above must be met prior to April 1*******

Dual Enrollment/MOWR Course Selections:

1. Courses approved for Dual Enrollment/MOWR will be courses that can be used to meet high school graduation requirements.
2. Students seeking to enroll full time in the Dual Enrollment/MOWR program will have the opportunity to enroll in their zoned high school - otherwise Dual Enrollment/MOWR courses must be able to fit into your school day schedule without removing your fine arts courses
3. Participating in the summer Dual Enrollment/MOWR program is suggested for freshman, sophomores, and juniors who are interested in the Dual Enrollment opportunities.

During advisement the following is required:

- A copy of your college acceptance letter
- A copy of your Dual Enrollment/MOWR participation agreement with your parent's signature (each semester)
- A list of classes in which you are interested in enrolling (each semester)

Important Information:

- If changes to class selections occur during the student's academic advisement with their college Dual Enrollment advisor, it is the student's responsibility to get approval from their high school counselor for the change in classes prior to registering for the college course.
- Students are responsible for ensuring an official copy of their college transcript is mailed to their high school counselor for accurate grade reporting.
- All grades earned in Dual Enrollment are included in the student's overall GPA and HOPE GPA as appropriate. Students should always do their best academic work as Dual Enrollment grades will be on their high school and college transcripts.
- Time management and prioritization will be vital assets to students participating in Dual Enrollment/MOWR.
